

HERONVILLE ON GROUSE CREEK, 1868.

This was the most disputed ground on Grouse Creek when the Canadian Company sunk a shaft to bed rock and then followed the lead onto a neighbouring claim. Officials, that included Governor Seymour, arrived on the creek to settle the theft of gold.
