Minty's Hamburgers

In 1938 Ruth and Bill Minty opened Minty's Hamburgers just to the west of Mussallem's Modern Motors.

Minty sold in 1940 to a Mrs. Beston, who sold a short time later to new owners who called the place the Best Café. Ruth Minty, née Robertson, was a great-granddaughter of Samuel Robertson.

The restaurant was later called Henry's Grill with the slogan "Finer Foods" and still later the Chinese Capital Café. It still exists as the Kitchen on the Ridge.
